

New Jersey announced the **COVID-19 Emergency Rental Assistance Program Phase II (CVERAP-II)** to assist eligible households struggling to pay rent and utilities due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Application Process

To be considered for the program, applicants must first submit an application beginning on **Monday, March 22, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. The State has indicated that the portal will be open 24 hours per day.** Applications will be accepted until enough have been received to distribute the funding amount. All applications will be entered into a randomized lottery. Applicants selected in the lottery will be notified by email.

Who is Eligible?

New Jersey households who:

- Qualify for unemployment or have faced a significant reduction in household income, incurred significant costs, or experienced a financial hardship due to COVID-19.
- Demonstrate a risk of homelessness or housing instability.
- Have a household income at or below 80% of area median income (AMI) based upon household size.
